Home-Hospital Instruction Parent Information/Application Process

The Gilroy Unified School District recognizes the importance of an uninterrupted education program and will make every effort to provide a home teacher whenever possible.

Eligibility Criteria.

- 1. Students may qualify for services if they are currently enrolled and live within Gilroy Unified School District boundaries.
- 2 Home teaching will be approved only if the pupil has been formally enrolled in a public school in the district prior to the time home instruction is requested.
- 3. No home teaching will be given unless the pupil is likely to be absent from school for a minimum of **two weeks**.

Procedures for Requesting Home Hospital Instruction

- The Home Hospital application is available at each school, District Office and on the District's Website (GUS#5).
- 2. The Home Hospital application must be filled out/signed by parent and physician. Along with the Home Hospital application, the parent must fill out/sign a Release of Information.
- 3. The completed Home Hospital application and Release of Information must be turned to the School Principal.
- 4. The School Nurse will follow-up by contacting parent and physician.
- 5. Approval/Denial letter will be mailed to parent.
- 6. If approved, a teacher will be assigned. The assigned teacher will contact the parent and instruction begins. Parents are responsible for picking up assignments from classroom teacher(s) until home hospital teacher is assigned.
- 7. It can take up to two weeks for the approval process and for a teacher to be assigned.
